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site analysis

The site of lastivka coop, situated 4 kilometers south of the centre of Lviv, is an area of 50.000 m² with approximately 1070 garages which find varied uses by their owners. Some spaces of mostly 25m² contain small car services, others are used for storage or small shops. Most of them are restricted to one floor.







map of Lviv






The railtrack in the north of Lastivka Coop is currently used only by freighttrains, but offers a possible usage fpr public transport in the future.

By creating certain new axes, which also structure the site, a connection between the surrounding green space and the new urban district will be created. By combining a pedestrian subway with a railway station, the faster access both between the neighbourhoods an to the city centre of Lviv will be given

connect with the heritage



The principle of the existing garages and workshops will also be included in the new concept. In order to preserve part of the original usage of the site, approximately one third of the area is planned to become a zone for creative workshops, which include among others car services and studios, and function as a buffer zone between the concrete jungle and the centre of the site.

new needed functions



As in Lviv is currently a growth in innovation and industry happening, there is a high need of new workplaces and study areas, which will be provided by the new innovation-campus. In order to offer the inhabitants of this mostly residential area an appropriate centre, there will be social institutions as well as shopping possibilitys, leisure zones and networking space.




